## Agreement for becoming a member group of Bus Users UK Ltd

1. A membership fee is payable on an annual basis for local group membership of Bus Users UK. Rates are agreed by the AGM and are published on the Bus Users UK website and in Bus User magazine
2. The Group's contact details will be published on Bus Users UK's website and in Bus User
3. Local groups will receive a copy of Bus User each quarter and the member who has signed the membership form will be entitled to vote (in person or by proxy) on behalf of the group at Bus Users UK Ltd's AGM
4. Main postholders of the group (eg chairman, secretary and treasurer) should be individual members of Bus Users UK
5. A copy of the group's constitution should be supplied to Bus Users UK's head office
6. The group's annual report (or other report at least once a year if no formal annual report is produced) should be submitted to Bus Users UK's head office
7. Any public statement made in the name of Bus Users UK must be cleared by Bus Users UK's head office (the group is of course free to comment in its own name without reference to Bus Users UK)
8. Local groups are free to use and adapt our guidance principles in a way which suits their local situation, but if we considered that the conduct of a group was widely at variance with the spirit of those principles, or with Bus Users UK's own aims and objectives, we would reserve the right to refuse or terminate membership
9. Bus Users UK may from time to time approach the group for information regarding issues surrounding bus services in its area, and may also ask for comments to inform national consultations on bus user issues
